Built and operated as the Pantages Theatre in 1916, it housed vaudeville performances during the 1910s and 1920s. It operated as the RKO Pan in 1946, when it started featuring movies. In 1961, it became the Mann Theatre, where it continued to show movies, including the sneak-preview screenings of *The Sound of Music* (which played for nearly two years) and *West Side Story*. In 2002, the theater reopened to offer off-Broadway shows and music concerts. Pantages Theatre opens at 5 PM or two hours prior to showtime for matinees, day of show only.
